



## **PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT**

### **ASSISTANCE**

Assist the coach and/or manager in the running of the team where required or requested.

### **DRESS**

Ensure that the player is properly attired in the approved club outfit.

### **COMMUNICATION**

Notify the coach/manager if the player cannot attend training or the game.

### **PUNCTUALITY**

Ensure that the player arrives at ground at least an hour before the start of a game and at least 15 minutes before the start of training.

### **TEAM SUPPORT**

Support the team - not individual players.

### **TRANSPORT**

Arrange for transport for the player to and from soccer activities.

### **ABUSE**

Eliminate verbal and physical abuse. Shout encouragement only.

### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

Treat the game as an entertainment and promote good sportsmanship.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Check out our website [www.theentrancesoccerclub.com.au](http://www.theentrancesoccerclub.com.au) and listen to 2GO on the morning of the game in case of inclement weather. ALSO use our Bounce Back SMS service – Text the word ENTWW to 199BBSMS and the latest Wet Weather info will be returned to your phone. There is a 55c charge to ANYONE that sends an SMS to 199 22767.

### **ENQUIRES**

Contact your team manager for any information. **Under no circumstances** should a parent or player contact the Committee for general information.

### **MEETINGS**

Attend, if interested, the Club's monthly general meeting – first Monday of the month at 7.00 p.m. A member must attend 4 monthly general meetings during the season to be eligible to vote at the A.G.M. of the Club.



## **CANTEEN ROSTER**

Provide assistance in the canteen at home games as per team roster.

## **TEAM TALKS**

Parents WILL NOT attend pre-match or half time talks.

## **TEAM DUG OUT**

Parents WILL NOT sit in the team's dug out unless an authorised official.

## **INSTRUCTIONS TO PLAYERS**

Parents WILL NOT give instructions to any players whilst in the care of the coach or manager.

## **UNDERTAKING**

Take a note that all players on being signed shall be required to sign an undertaking agreeing to the following:

- a. They shall abide by all decision of the Team Coach and Manager.
- b. The rules of soccer football as applicable to the CCF Ltd. and its governing bodies.
- c. The By-Laws and Regulations governing Entrance Club team soccer and the decisions of the Committee as made from time to time.

Further, the undertaking shall give authority to the particular squad manager to obtain all necessary medical treatment that may be required whilst the player is in the care of the aforesaid manager and also shall indemnify the squad manager and the Club and Committees for all damage whatsoever caused by the player.

## **INSURANCE**

All players are recommended to be covered by their own, or in the case of juniors, their parents and/or guardians for full private hospital/medical and should be covered in an ambulance scheme. The Club will not be responsible for the payment of any medical claims.

The Committee will be responsible to pay an annual subscription fee for each player into a compulsory insurance policy administered by the governing body which is set up for such purposes. Such fee to form part of the player registration fee. The maximum medical/ hospital claim from this policy is \$2,000

## **DISPUTE**

If any conflict arises, the matter shall be referred to the Team manager and Coach for resolution. If this cannot be settled then the matter shall be referred to the Liaison Officer and if still not satisfied, then in writing to the Committee.
